LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Purpose: To recognize those individuals, who by their work over the course of their career as an addiction professional have improved the quality of services provided to individuals with or affected by addiction, reduced the stigma associated with addiction and made a positive impact on the lives of individuals with addiction, their families and their communities in South Carolina.

Award Criteria: The Board of Directors of the South Carolina Association of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors (SCAADAC) shall at their discretion select individuals to receive the Lifetime Achievement Award based on criteria such as:

1. A minimum of 25 years working in the field of addiction treatment, prevention or recovery in the state of South Carolina.
2. Served a minimum of four years in an elected or appointed capacity on the Board of Directors of SCAADAC or the SCAADAC Certification Commission or a minimum of four years on state, regional, national or international organizational boards or commissions whose primary function is addiction treatment, prevention and recovery.
3. Have been recognized at a state, national or international level for exemplary service in the field of addiction treatment, prevention and recovery.

Required:

4. Have Letters of Recommendation from at least two current or previous members of the SCAADAC Board of Directors or SCAADAC Certification Commission.
5. Is a member of SCAADAC (NAADAC membership required).

Award Procedure: This award shall be given when in the judgment of the SCAADAC Board of Directors an individual who meets the Award Criteria exists.

1. Any member in good standing of SCAADAC can submit a nomination to the President of SCAADAC. The nomination should document the award criteria, include the letters of recommendation and provide justification as to why the nominated individual merits the award.
2. The President of SCAADAC will present the nomination to the full board of SCAADAC. The Board will determine if the nomination rises to the level of receiving the Award.
3. The Award will be presented at the SCAADAC Annual Conference and will be announced prior to the Conference.
